KS LTAP is teaming up with FHWA to provide in-person ADA training to local agencies this fall (hopefully). In order to be eligible to attend the in-person training, please watch the 23 minute video by New Jersey LTAP titled, "ADA Basic Requirements, Self-Evaluations and Transition Plans for Public Right-of-Way," and take a short knowledge check. A score of 80% on the knowledge check will satisfy the prerequisite for the ADA training to be conducted in fall of 2020. You may take the test multiple times.
